

Diploma of Facilities Management

Developed by the Facility Management Association of Australia in conjunction with UNE Partnerships and industry, the Diploma of Facilities Management is designed to meet the skills and knowledge required for facilities managers who lead, manage and maintain internal and external facility operation teams and services.

The Diploma was developed specifically to meet the needs of the facilities management industry and is wholly supported and recommended by FMA, the peak Australian national body. The course is not currently accredited under the Australian Qualifications Framework, however it is intended to be established as the benchmark for industry training in Australia at the Diploma level and future accreditation has been a primary focus of the development.

The Diploma qualification supports existing skills and knowledge and develops new capabilities in such areas as:

- The planning, development and implementation of facilities maintenance and lifecycle maintenance programs.
- Measuring and managing sustainable facilities environments.
- Managerial business skills, including an understanding of collaboration, interpersonal

- relationships, stakeholder engagement and delegation.
- Risk management and an understanding of how to ensure safety in the workplace.

Leadership and Management

Certificate IV in Leadership and Management (BSB42015)

This qualification is ideal for those moving into their first leadership or management role or who are already leading a small team and have some decision-making responsibility. It is designed to provide a skills base for emerging and future leaders, and develops practical knowledge in leading and managing people and getting the best out of a team. The course also covers the broad range of business skills such as developing teams, project work, and implementing various business operations such as operational plans, customer service strategies, health and safety policies and risk policies.
