Demonstrating practical skills

This course requires students to demonstrate practical skills. If you work in General Practice or other service where there is a Registered Nurse or GP on staff you can ask this person to observe and confirm that you have satisfactorily demonstrated the necessary skills through completion of observation checklists

If you do not have access to a clinician in your workplace you will need to demonstrate practical skills through either of the following methods:

- Video demonstration to your allocated UNEP assessor
- Real time demonstration to your Assessor via a video call.

Study workload

The nominal duration of your enrolment in the *HLTSS00064 Infection Control Skill Set* is 6 weeks. The time it takes you to achieve the competencies required will depend on the amount of relevant learning and experience you have. Students with a moderate level of relevant learning and experience should be able to complete the program requirements in about 13 hours of self-directed study over this period.

The NSW Government has set a strict timeframe for completion of this course. There will be no extensions allowed to the expected completion date.

Accreditation and recognition

The *HLTSS00064 Infection Control Skill Set* in which you are enrolled is a nationally recognised Skill Set listed on the national register.
